Welcome to M:T '24! We are thrilled you're here.

Much prayer has taken place in preparation for this event. We're eager to see God work through what's in store for today:

- Our theme is *Not a Competition*. We've invited four dynamic disciples of Jesus to speak on this important message to practically and powerfully reignite your passion for missions.
- A variety of experienced evangelical practitioners will lead breakout sessions from which you will leave equipped and empowered.



PRAYER Points

- We pray the Holy Spirit will develop a sense of unity, purity, and peace within your congregation and leadership.
- We pray we will submit to where the Holy Spirit leads us in the area of missions.
- Forgive us for not prioritizing prayer, for working in isolation, for leveraging our own mission above the Lord's Commission, and for measuring success based on finances or people in the pew.
- We pray for unity in the broader church in our area. We desire to unite over more than humanitarian efforts, but through gospel-driven activities to bless our neighbors. Help us reach the rich, poor, comfortable, and vulnerable with the saving message of Jesus Christ.
- We pray the Holy Spirit will help us leave our logos, egos, and silos at the door to grow for God's glory. We pray the Lord will use M:T to that end.



BRING M:T TO YOUR CHURCH

Developing a missional identity in a congregation takes time, intention, and prayer. Churches can slip into ministry mode, which can easily mean maintenance mode. M:T desires to assist churches in moving beyond maintenance — into mission.

We invite you to consider the following questions with your congregation:

If you are a pastor, consider bringing these questions to your core leadership group:

- Can our congregation list all of our missionaries?
- What kind of relationship do we have with our missionaries?
- Do we have a structure in place, to develop our relationship with our missionaries and their communities?
- What leadership pipelines could we develop to catalyze missional activities both locally and abroad?





BRING M:T TO YOUR CHURCH

If you are a dedicated member of your church, but you do not have a place of leadership, consider the following:

- Which member of your congregation can you invite into a discipling relationship?
- If you had an opportunity to meet with your pastors or leadership board, what questions would you ask to create a stronger missional culture in your church?
- How is prayer central to how you engage with your local congregation? How could you mobilize a growing prayer ministry within your church in the area of evangelism, outreach, and discipleship?

If you are a member of a missions committee or team, consider bringing these questions to your next meeting:

- How are we developing younger members in the areas of evangelism, outreach, and discipleship?
- What subset of talent do we have in our congregation, and in what ways can we mobilize those talents to bless our community?
- Can we bring questions to the core leadership for a time of discovery? For example, could we discuss with our elder or deacon board how missions, prayer, and discipleship remain top priorities? How can we measure success in these areas of ministry?




